



Online Learning: Staying Safe




VIDEO CALLS

- Keep your parents / carer close-by so they can help you or speak to your teacher.
- You must wear day clothes or school uniform.
- Teachers expect the same language and behaviour as at school.
- Ask a parent / carer to check the video call has finished.
- Make sure you have some space to do the work your teacher gives you.
- Never share personal details or video call details.



INSTAGRAM / FACEBOOK

- You must be at least 13 years old to have a Facebook or Instagram account.
- Always ask your parents / carers before using Facebook or Instagram.
- Keep your parents in the room when using Facebook or Instagram.
- Never talk to someone you don't know online.
- Never tell anyone your password or personal information (where you live, your age, your birthday).



YOUTUBE

- Find the Chiltern Wood School channel!
- Never use YouTube on your own.
- If you find a video or advert that makes you feel uncomfortable, let your parent or carer know straight away.
- Remember to take screen breaks.
- Ask your parents to set up a YouTube Kids app account.
