Leaders are tenacious in ensuring that pupils are safe. This includes providing support that goes beyond their statutory duties, such as conducting home visits. All staff demonstrate a high level of care for pupils and know how to keep them safe.

If any parents have concerns they would like to discuss, then please do make an appointment to come in and speak to me. The Governing Body are fully aware of the case and wholeheartedly support the school. I would like to thank parents who I have spoken to on this matter for their support for the school, and the recognition of the strong practice that exists within the school to keep children safe.

In far more important matters, the school has had a busy two weeks back with Woodlands Fashion Show, Stay and Play, a visit from the people from the Science Dome, World Book Day and Buddy Week. The children have had a great time learning and engaging with the curriculum. It was also great to hear of such a good turnout for our parent workshop this week run by the Learning Disability nurses.
