Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back after half term – despite the horrible weather I hope you managed to enjoy the week.

Another week, more changes as far as the national and local picture is concerned with regard to Coronavirus. The DfE issued guidance for schools on Wednesday afternoon. I will separately draw out the significant messages from that guidance, although in summary it will not significantly change our practice. The key messages around hygiene practices remain the cornerstone of effective measures against the spread of the virus. Whilst you will have noted from my parentmail messages there have been further cases within the school community, we have had (to date, at least) no cases where it has spread within the school. I appreciate these are troubling times, but we continue to remain committed to ensuring your children receive an excellent education, and do everything we can to do this in a safe and responsible way. We continue to thank parents for playing their part, and adhering to the guidelines set by the government in order that we do all we can to control the rate of infection.

Just before half term I worked with the governors to approve our School Development Plan for this year. There are 10 objectives in total, but I'd like to share these 3 with you in the first instance:

- Develop an outstanding curriculum encompassing communication, reading, writing and ICT
- Develop technology within the school to enable access for all
- Ensure there is a robust remote learning package in place to support all learners across the school

You'll note there is a connection between these targets, and that the current situation with the pandemic factors into our considerations. I hope to be able to expand further on these and other targets over the year.

On a final note, I wanted to commend two of our non teaching staff on milestones in their career within Buckinghamshire. Firstly Greg Ray from the Downley site has reached the 10 year mark within Bucks, and Andrew Evans from the Cressex site team has logged an impressive 30 years. Both members of staff are hugely valued by all staff across the school for the important job they do in keeping the sites running. Our grateful thanks to them both.


